- 15 minute Provocation Sessions in which three community members/teams will each take 15 minutes in quick succession to present a tight, visually supported provocation (think TED Talks or Ignite Talks) followed by 15 minutes for everyone in the room to engage in small group discussions reacting to the set of three provocations
